We will be leaving for the retreat facility at 6:00 PM sharp! Please be prepared to park your vehicle for the weekend at Bridge of Hope or have someone drop you off as <u>transportation will be provided to the retreat facility</u>.

Returning from the retreat:

We will be returning to Bridge of Hope (address above) for the "Welcome Home Celebration" at 6:00 PM on Sunday evening. We <u>highly</u> encourage your loved ones and friends to attend the "Welcome Home Celebration". Please have your loved ones and friends arrive for the celebration between 5:40 and 5:50 PM.

What to Bring:

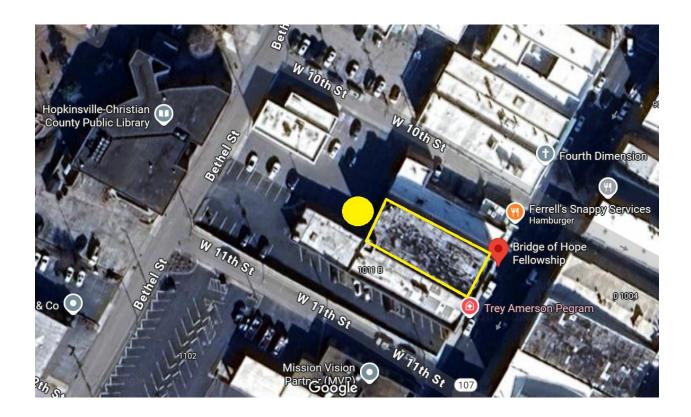
- 1. Comfortable (modest) clothing for 3 days and 2 nights. Please nothing inappropriate for a group setting. Bring additional clothes if you wish to be baptized.
- 2. Twin size bed sheet/blanket or sleeping bag and a pillow. Cabins are heated and air conditioned, but plan accordingly.
- 3. Bring slippers or other foot covering to wear inside the cabin. Bare feet and socks will become dirty.
- 4. Shower shoes or slippers to wear in and around the showers.
- 5. Please pack all belongings in <u>one</u> luggage piece (preferably a <u>single</u> duffel bag). Only a sleeping bag, rolled tight, will be accepted as a second piece.
- 6. Personal hygiene items such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, towel for bathing & towel for baptism.

- 7. Ear plugs for light sleepers (accommodations are group dorm setting).
- 8. Meals and lodging are provided but you may want to purchase other items at the celebration (i.e. shirts, etc.).
- 9. A small umbrella, insect repellant and a jacket/sweatshirt.
- 10. Most Importantly bring an **OPEN HEART!**

At the Bridge of Hope (yellow rectangle), drop off and parking will be at the back of the building designated by the yellow circle, which is accessible from West 10th Street (from Bethel Street). There will be folks there to direct offloading, parking, etc. For those not familiar with Hopkinsville:

- South Main Street is a one way street in front of the Bridge of Hope
- West 10th Street is a one way street (access it from Bethel Street)
- West 11th Street is a one way street (access it from South Main Street)



Below shows the entrance we will use at the Bridge of Hope. This is what you will see as you are driving down West 10^{th} Street (from Bethel Street towards South Main Street).
